THE CONGRESSIONAL EXECUTIONISTS. - Memphis, Dec. 25. - The Congressional executionists started last evening from Nashville by special train, accompanied by a delegation from Nashville, and arrived here this evening. They were met at an intermediate point, on the Tennessee road by a committee of reception, composed of the Mayor and Members of the Common Council and a large number of citizens.

Gov. Worth's Inaugural Address. Delivered in the Presence of both Houses of the General Assembly, in the House of Commons, on the 22d of December 1866.

It is known to you that the pressure of important official duties, for some days past, has left me no time for the preparation of a formal inaugural address. The orders of Gen. Sickles forbidding our Courts to execute laws which have existed with us and our ancestors for many hundred years, in the face of the previous proclamation of the President - declaring that civil law existed in all the States which had engaged in the late rebellion, astounded the State.
