Legal Notice

NOTICE OF AN ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE TOWN OF DUNN, N. C. TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE CITY MANAGER FORM OF GOVERNMENT SHALL BE RETAINED THEREIN OR WHETHER THE SAME SHALL BE ABOLISHED.

Whereas at a special meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the town of Dunn held on Tuss. March 13, 1951, at the Municipal Building, Dunn, N. C., the following order was made:

Whereas, under the provisions of an act of the 1951 General Assembly of North Carolina which act was passed finally on March 6, 1951, and was originally designated as Senate Bill 174, the Board of Commissioners were directed to order an election to be held on a Saturday on or before April 14, 1951, to determine whether the city manager form of government shall be retained therein or whether the Town of Dunn shall operate after May 31, 1951, under the same charter, applicable laws and forms of government which were in effect prior to the adoption of the present city manager form of government:

Now therefore, be it ordered by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Dunn, N. C., as follows:

1. That special election be and the same is hereby called for Saturday, April 14, 1951, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the Town of Dunn, the question of whether or not the city manager form of government shall be retained in the said Town of Dunn, N. C., or whether the same shall be abolished.
2. That ballots to be used in said special election shall be in substantially the following form:
TOWN OF DUNN, N. C.
SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION
APRIL 14, 1951
FOR CITY MANAGER FORM OF GOVERNMENT AGAINST CITY MANAGER FORM OF GOVERNMENT
To vote for the retention of the city manager form of government, place a cross mark in the square to the right of the words "For City Manager Form of Government."
To vote against the retention of the city manager form of government, place a cross mark in the square to the right of the words "Against City Manager Form of Government."
3. That J. A. Creel, be and he is hereby appointed Registrar for said special election; and that Thad H. Pope and R. A. Draughon be and they are hereby appointed judges

for said special election, and that the polling place shall be the City Hall, Dunn, N. C.

4. That the said Election shall be conducted in all respects as is now provided by the laws governing the holding of municipal elections in the Town of Dunn, and the laws governing the holding of municipal elections in this State not inconsistent with the said Act dated March 6, 1951, and referred to above in this order.

Now, therefore, all qualified voters residing within the corporate limits of the Town of Dunn, N. C., are hereby notified that an election to determine the City Manager form of government shall be retained in said Town of Dunn, N. C. shall operate in the future under the same charter applicable laws, and form of government which were in effect prior to the adoption of the city manager form of government, will be held in the Town of Dunn, N. C., on Saturday, April 14, 1951; and that J. A. Creel has been appointed Registrar for said election and that Thad H. Pope, and Robert A. Draughon have been appointed judges for said election; and that the City Hall, Dunn, N. C., has been designated as the polling place for said election, and the hours designated by law for holding said election are from 6:30 A. M. to 6:30 P. M., Eastern Standard Time.

All unregistered voters, residing within the corporate limits of the Town of Dunn, N. C., are notified to register for this election, because the New Registration of all qualified voters, residing within the corporate limits of the Town of Dunn, on March 5th, 1951, will not apply to the said special election ordered by
