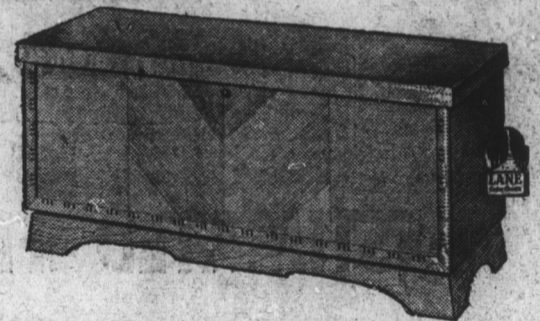
4. A drawing by Al Capp of the national winner will appear in the LI'L ABNER comic strip at the earliest possible date.

6. Entries cannot be returned and become the property of Quinn Furniture Co. and United Feature Syndicate.

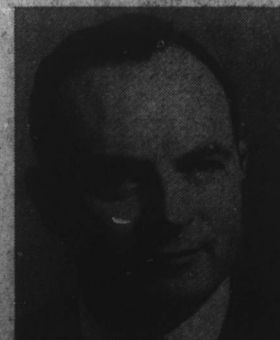
