High Average Seen
The sales supervisor also predicted that the average price may run close to \$50 a hundred pounds. Last year farmers were paid out nearly \$5,250,000 for just under 9,000,000 pounds of leaf sold on the Dunn market, McCullers stated.

The two warehouse firms operating Dunn are the Big Four, operated by Buck Curran and associates, and the Farmers and Growers, operated by Dick Owens.

McCullers said that the best year in the market's history is expected in 1951, since both Imperial and Export tobacco companies of Richmond are expected to have buyers here. If those firms come in, he declared, Dunn will have 10 buyers—the largest single set of buyers in the State.

Early Market Reports
Reports on tobacco sales on the Georgia-Florida Belt markets will be sent to Dunn by Buck Curran who will be operating on the Tipton, Ga., market, said McCullers. The reports will be made as a service to the Dunn tobacco market and tobacco farmers from this area. The tobacco market was established here in 1948 as a project of the Dunn Chamber of Commerce.
