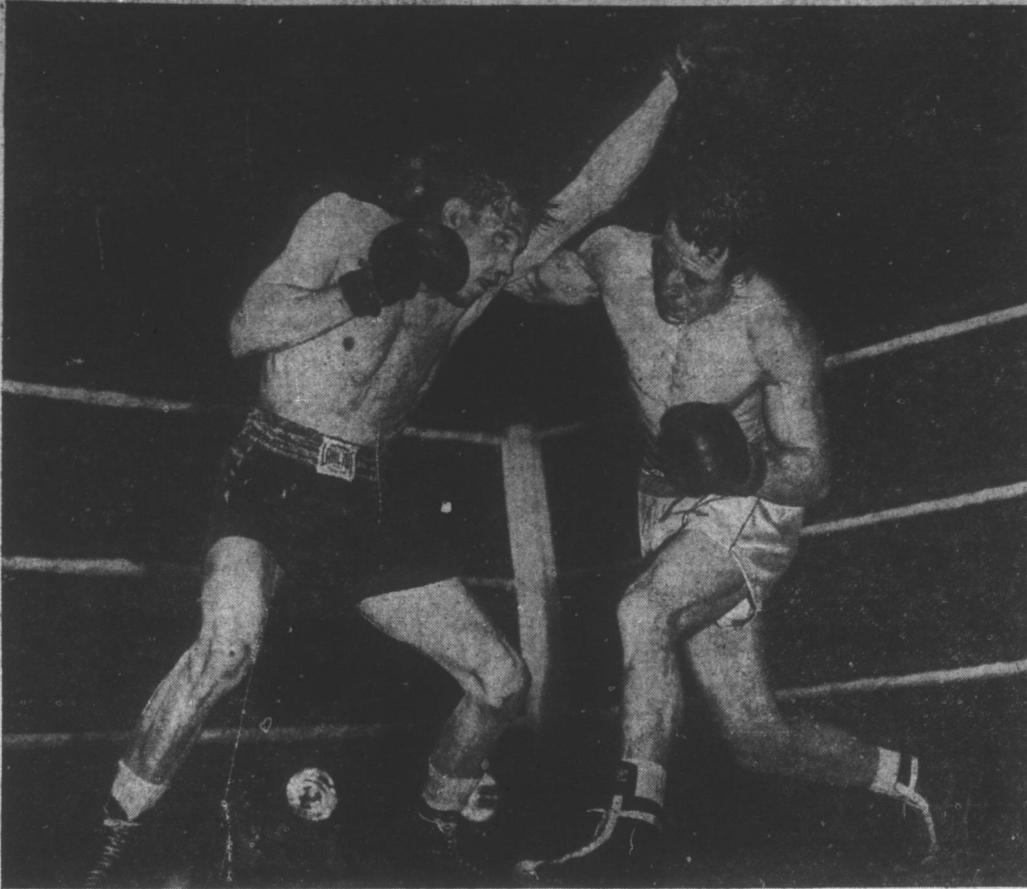
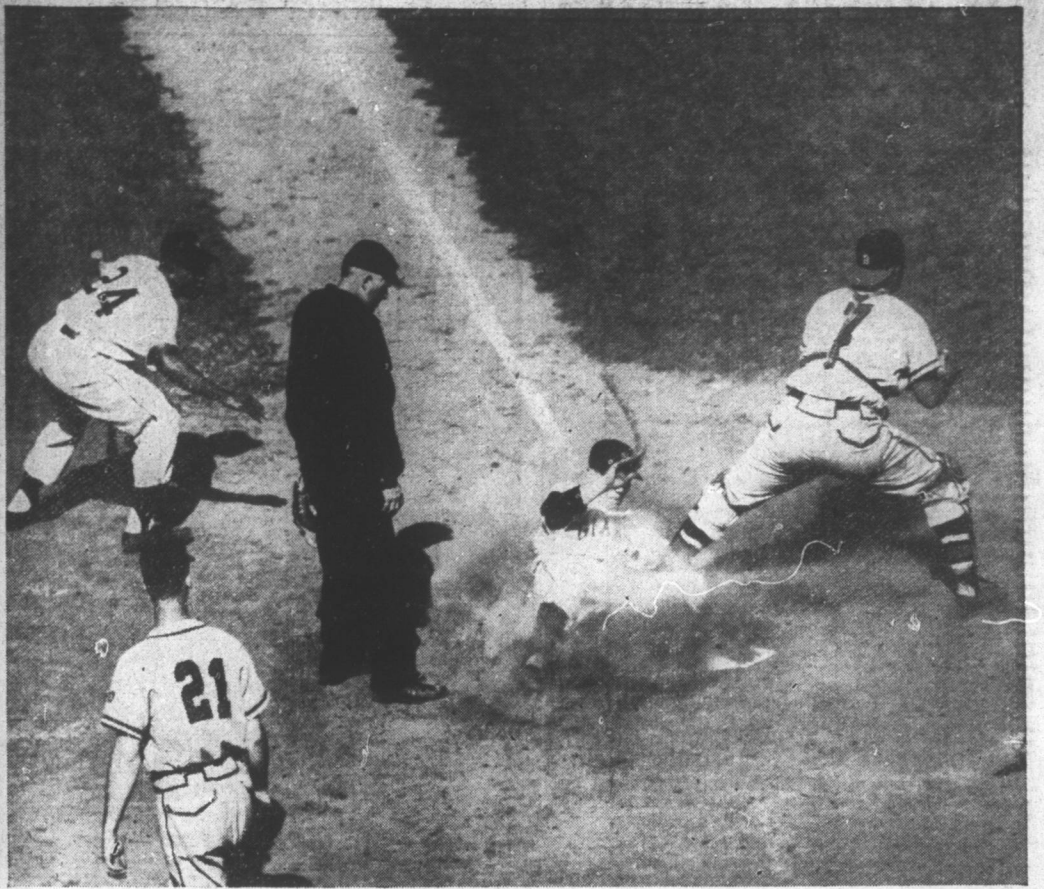


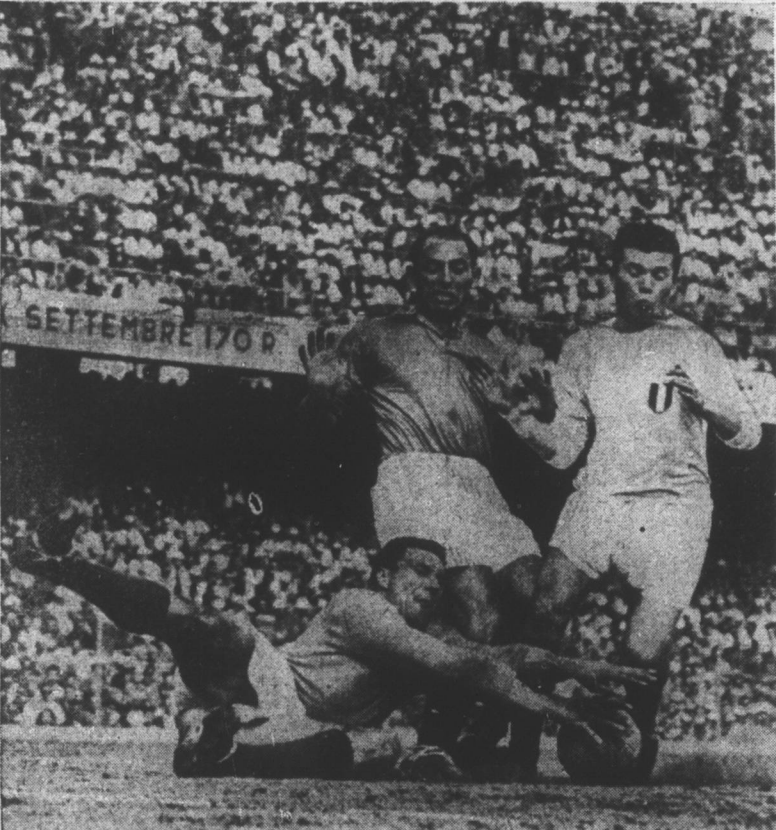
Highlights in the World of Sports

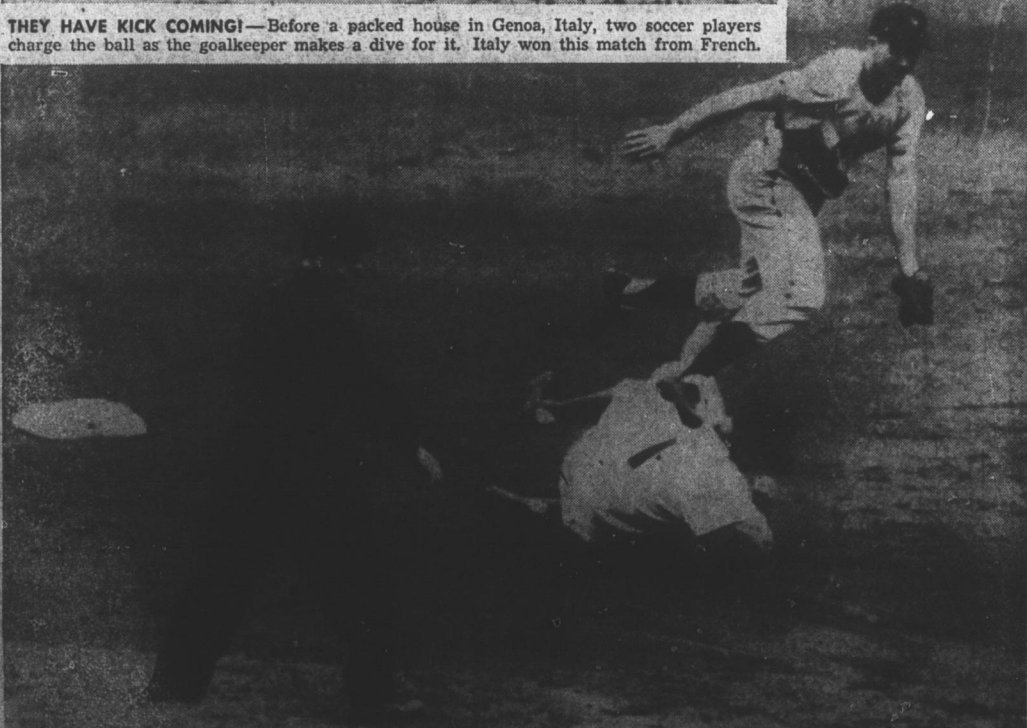
