## Woodmen Set For Orphan Program

With the Erwin Camp as host, many Woodmen dignitaries will join in the annual Christmas Party to be held Saturday evening, December 22, in the Erwin High School with the children from the Falcon Orphanage and the Dunn Free Will Baptist Orphanage as special guests. It was announced today by J. E. (Fate) Williams, Council Commander of the Erwin Camp.

For several weeks the 400 N. C. Woodmen Camps have been raising money to provide a Christmas Party for approximately two thousand orphan children at Christmas parties to be held throughout the State. Camps in the Fayetteville, Dunn, Erwin, Goldsboro sections will join in the party to be held this Saturday evening in the Erwin High School.

Among the officials expected to attend will be Dr. Wm. Howard Carter, Goldsboro, Clergyman; and Fraternalist. Dr. Carter has been directing the public relations for the campaign to raise the funds for the party in Eastern Carolina. Dr. Carter is a state officer of the fraternity. He is expected to be accompanied by Mrs. Carter to the party.

Heading the state wide event is Hiram Melvin, former Head Council, and now assistant State Manager of Charlotte and White Lake. Melvin is widely known in this section, having served as Principal of the Clement High School several years before becoming an officer of the W. O. W.

Each child from both the Dunn and Falcon Orphanages will receive a personal gift as a special Christmas gift from the W. O. W. Captain Harvey Williams, officer of the Uniform Bank, has already announced that the party to be held this year is expected to be the largest ever held in this section.
