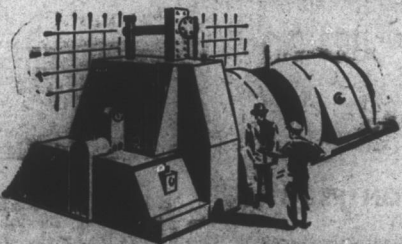

liamson of Elizabethtown; and three grandchildren. Mr. Caison was a deacon in the Baptist Church and a former town commissioner of Roseboro.

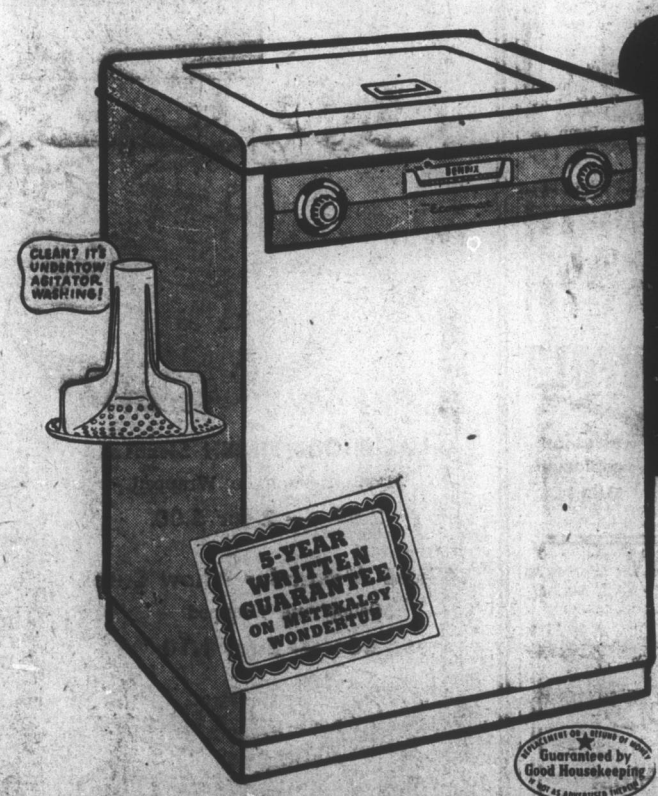
