Cuthrell Lectureship To Feature Meeting

WILSON - The first George F. Cuthrell Lectureship will highlight the mid-winter meeting of the North Carolina Christian Ministers Association to be held on the campus of Atlantic Christian College in the spring of 1951 by the Hood Memorial Christian Church of Dunn, N. C. honors Dr. George F. Cuthrell, present pastor of the church, for his distinguished career as a minister of the Disciples of Christ for over half a century.

Announcement of the lectureship was made during Atlantic Christian College's spring commencement week in May of 1951 at which time Dr. Cuthrell gave the baccalaureate address. A native of Pamlico County, Dr. Cuthrell has held influential pastorates in Georgia, Texas and North Carolina. He was pastor of the Hillier Memorial Christian Church of Raleigh from 1924 to 1930.

For three years Dr. Cuthrell served as a member of the Atlantic Christian College board of trustees.
