DIPHTHERIA, WHOOPING COUGH, TETANUS, SMALLPOX AND TYPHOID FEVER.

All Clinics For White And Colored All Treatment Free.

DIPHTHERIA deaths usually occur in very young children. There were 19 such deaths in North Carolina last year. We urge that the Toxoid be given at the age of 3 months.

WHOOPING COUGH killed 52 children in North Carolina in 1951. This vaccine should also be given at 3 months of age.

TETANUS (lock-jaw) is a very deadly disease and can be prevented. Fortunately all three of the above treatments can be given in COMBINATION, thus lessening the number of injections required.

SMALLPOX vaccination should be done in childhood and once later in life.

• Typhoid Fever has been almost eliminated but the vaccine is still available for those who want it - one dose every year.
