

BIG DAY FOR AIR-COACH TOURISTS



THE RUSH IS ON at Idlewild Airport, New York, as one of the first groups of tourists to take advantage of the newly inaugurated air-coach service between the U. S. and Europe got under way. Eleven trans-Atlantic airlines are taking part in the new low-cost service. The fare from New York to London is \$270 one way, compared to the regular fare of \$395.

In Lillington, the Rev. T. W. Williams, pastor of the Lillington First Baptist Church will preach the baccalaureate sermon on Sunday night at 8:00 at the school.

The executive-Secretary of the Baptist State Convention, the Rev. O. L. Sherill will be the baccalaureate speaker at Harnett County Training School at 3:00.

The Rev. C. V. Horton, pastor of Mitchell Chapel Church at in Pittsboro will deliver the sermon at Johnsonville School at 8:00 p. m.

The Rev. J. W. Lineberger will be speaker at the Coats school at 7:30 p. m. He is pastor of Fuquay Methodist Church.

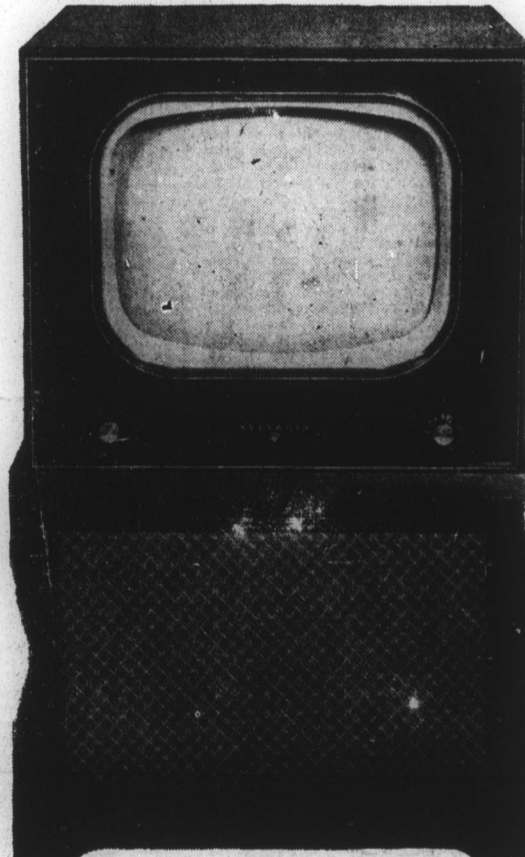
