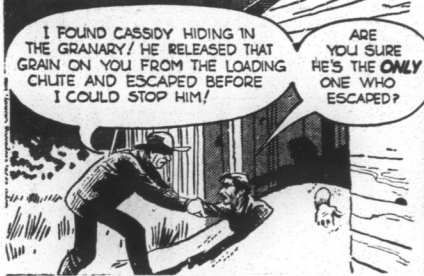
TO NEW JERSEY
