Uniform Traffic Courts Proposed

RALEIGH (AP) - A proposal for a uniform system of state traffic courts today awaited members of the General Assembly that will convene here in January.

L. R. Fisher, state motor vehicles commissioner, said the present system of handling cases in frequently unjust and cuts into the efficiency of the highway patrol. Fisher said there is a need for uniformity. He said a motorist cited in Iredell County face court costs totaling \$39, while he would face court costs running to only \$9 in nearby Mecklenburg. Fisher urged the legislators to provide a system of traffic courts with at least one in every county. He said the judges should be appointed by the governor and receive a straight salary instead of fees.

Suspected Commy Accepted By Army

WASHINGTON (AP) - Lt. Shepard Carl Thierman, 31-year-old army physician and Korean veteran, told Senate investigators that the army "never questioned" his refusal to say whether he was a Communist, it was disclosed today. The Senate Internal Security subcommittee identified Thierman as the officer whose military career it has been checking. It had previously accused the army of assigning him to a "sensitive spot"
