Farmers Asked To Grow Spuds

WASHINGTON - The Agriculture Department has asked American farmers today to produce 359,000,000 bushels of white potatoes in 1953, three per cent more than this year and "enough to meet all known requirements."

The department also announced a goal of 40,670,000 bushels for sweet potatoes, 39 per cent more than this year's below-average crop of 29,400,000 bushels.
