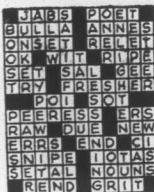


USEFUL JET SCOTTSBLUFF, Neb. —(AP)— Lt. Harry Schurr of the Air Force came here to wed Phyllis Braum

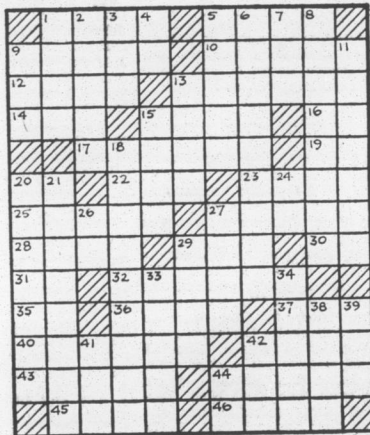
but forgot to bring the ring. One of his buddies in a jet plane squadron flew the ring from Moses Lake, Wash., in a matter of hours.

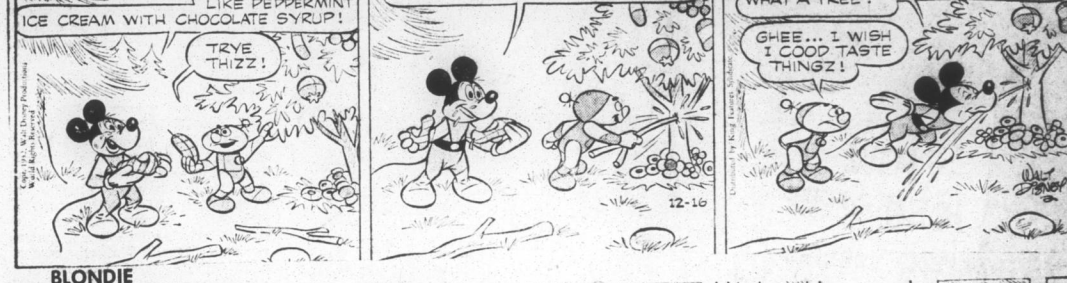
