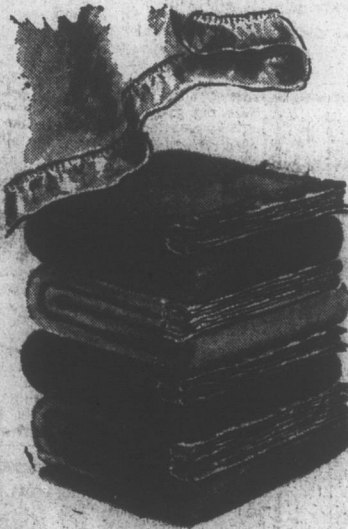

Steel Joints Prove Help To Crippled Pets

CHICAGO (P) — Household pets, crippled by bone disease or fractures of the hip, can be helped to walk normally again on stainless steel joints.

Spokesmen for the American Veterinary Medical Association said the operation was first used on human beings 10 years ago. Its adaptation for use on cats and dogs is a recent one they said.

The operation replaces the diseased or broken part of the hip with a steel ball and shaft.

The AVMA referred to a report by Dr. Roger E. Brown, veterinary graduate student at Michigan State College, on the techniques used to make the substitution.

X-rays are first taken to determine the size needed for the replacement part. After the ball and shaft are shaped to fit, surgery is performed under anesthetic to remove the diseased or broken bones. The replacement part is then installed.

Brown reported that dogs regained full use of their legs and a normal gait within a week.

Coyotes Not Fussy About Their Food

SACRAMENTO, Calif. (P) — The California Department of Fish and Game reports that a California coyote will eat almost anything—from watermelon to rattlesnake.

Department researchers' analyses of more than 2,200 coyote stomachs in the past 12 years have turned up evidence of rattlesnakes, insects, small birds, livestock and deer, skunk, watermelon, manzanita berries and poison oak leaves.

However the most popular item on the bill of fare was rodents — particularly meadow mice.
