First Day Of Summer, But Heat Early

 Summer had already worn out its welcome in many parts of the nation as it made its bow today. Summer officially begins at 5:55 p. m. EST, but the dying spring has already given a blazing preview of hot weather.

A record-breaking heat wave gripped the Midwest for the second week; floods forced hundreds to flee their homes in Iowa, and storms and tornadoes ripped the nation's midsection on the last day of spring.

The Iowa floods, following a week of torrential rains, were believed to have ruined millions of dollars worth of crops. A state of emergency was ordered at Sioux City, Ia., and the state weather forecast was for more rain.

At least three persons were killed yesterday as a result of the storms and floods.

The battle between cool and hot air produced at least three tornadoes in Nebraska and near tornado winds in Ohio yesterday.

Heavy rains and 50-mile-an-hour winds swept the Chicago area, disrupting a 65-yacht race on Lake Michigan. The yacht Aloha capsized and exploded, sending five men into the water. All were rescued.

Anti-Liquor Group Heard

WASHINGTON (AP) — Religious and temperance groups testified today that Americans are so hounded by the voice of "liquordom" that they almost believe it wrong to lead sober lives.

They said liquor advertisers, through radio and television advertising, are storming the confines of homes and corrupting the minds of the nation's youth.

Witnesses of religion and temperance groups made these charges before a Senate Commerce subcommittee considering legislation to ban liquor, wine, and beer advertising in interstate commerce.

Methodist Bishop Wilbur E. Hamaker, the first of 26 supporting witnesses, said alcohol advertising over radio and television has become "an insolent intruder" which "barges into the homes of the land and blatantly proclaims its untruths in the living rooms of millions."

Dr. C. Emanuel Carlson, executive director of the Baptist Joint Committee on Public Affairs, said Americans are so "hounded" by "the enslaving influence of the voice of liquor" that "we are wrong even to want to lead sober lives."
