Sen. Kerr Wins Term By Default

OKLAHOMA CITY, Okla. UP - Sen. Robert S. Kerr apparently won Oklahoma's Democratic senatorial nomination today by virtue of his chief opponent's reluctance to wage a costly runoff battle.

Former Gov. Roy J. Turner, who ran second to Kerr in last Tuesday's primary, Monday night dropped out of the scheduled July 27 runoff election between them.

Turner, like Kerr an oil millionaire, said "lack of finances and that lack only" forced his withdrawal.

A platoon leader in the division, Lieutenant Jones entered the Army in July 1952 and arrived in Korea last January. He is the son of Mrs. Pearl Jones, 2008 Echols st., Bryan, Tex.
