Teachers can make education more meaningful to the student, he said, by introducing them to real-life activities and the real-life situation.  
"Children learn by doing, feeling, experiencing," he said. "The teacher must draw on the human, material, social, institutional and capital resources—all of them—to make the most impression with her lessons."  
Conference host was F. H. Ledbetter, principal of Harnett High Schools. G. T. Proffitt, superintendent of Harnett County schools, gave a welcoming talk to the assembled teachers. A panel discussion on resource-use education was moderated by T. R. Moore, city councilman of Southern Pines and the panel members were Miss Joi Lemsen, of the Harnett Welfare Dept.; Lemuel R. Johnson, register of deeds in Chatham County; Milton Cheshire, county commissioner of Lee County and Clifton Blue, state legislator of Moore county.

Invocation was delivered by Rev. A. T. McDaniel, pastor of Saint John Baptist Church. The Shawtown Elementary Chorus sang, and there was a closing solo by P. C. Hill, teacher at Harnett High School and another solo, "Wherever You Walk," by Vilena Morgan of Shawtown School.  
Dr. Brown was introduced by R. C. Simmons, president of the Harnett County unit of the NCTA. Miss Willie M. Jeffries was coordinator of the student playlets which made up the latter part of the program.  
"Improvement of Economic Status Through Savings," was presented by W. B. Wicker School of Sanford; "Through Education," by Goldston High School; "Through Housing," by Academy Heights, Pinehurst; "Through Business," by Gentry Elementary School, Erwin.

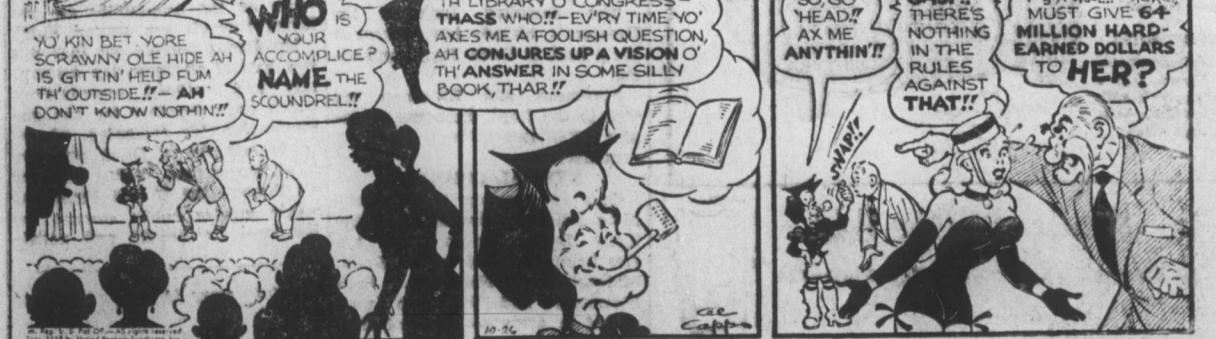
