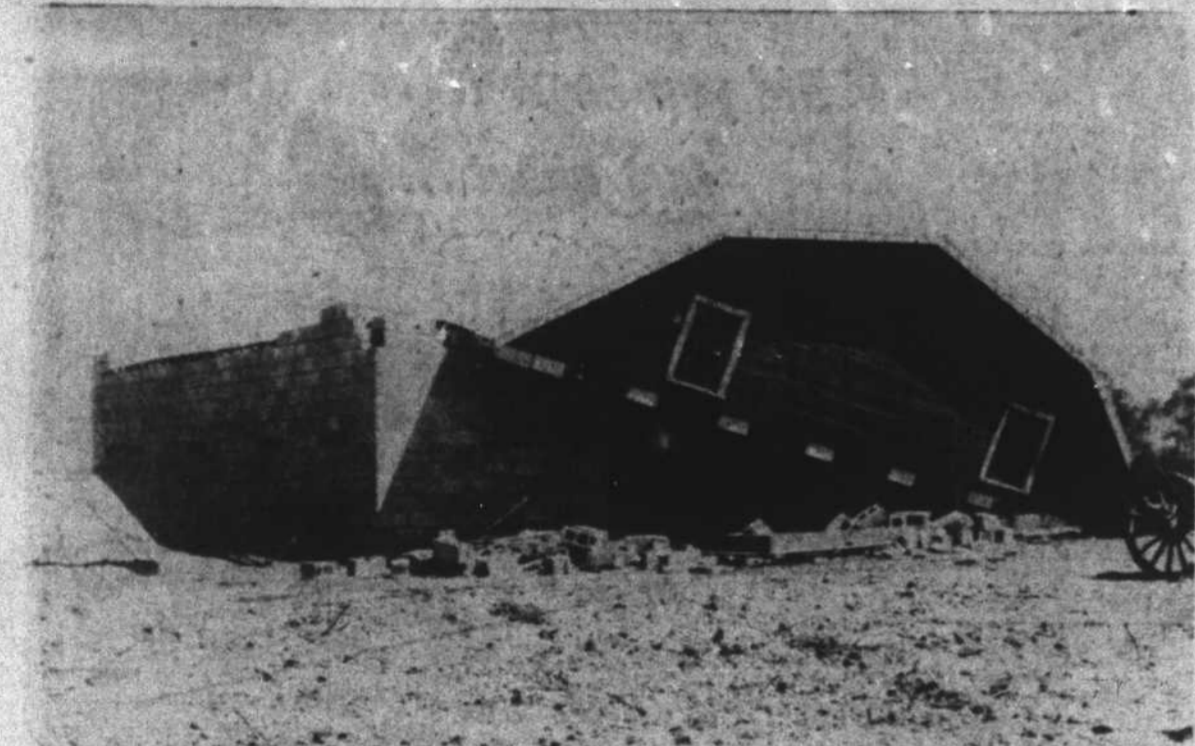

WASHINGTON (AP) — Atty-lai E. Stevenson and Sen. Estes Kefauver will engage in their first face-to-face debate as part of their battle for Florida's 23 Democratic National Convention votes.
