### BULLETINS

WASHINGTON (UP)—Attorneys indicated today that they are seeking a compromise settlement of the legal battle to keep James R. Hoffa from taking over as president of the Teamsters Union. The lengthy trial is in recess until next Monday. But half a dozen attorneys involved in the case were closeted in chambers today with presiding Judge F. Dickson Letts.

WASHINGTON (UP)—Sen. Lister Hill (D.Ala.) proposed today that the United States launch a program of "health for peace" through both domestic and international efforts. In a speech prepared for the Senate, he also criticized President Eisenhower for budgeting less this year than Congress voted last year for research to combat cancer and heart disease.

WASHINGTON (UP)—Nearly one third of the nation's major industrial centers today were listed as areas of "substantial" unemployment. They are eligible for special consideration now in the award of government contracts. Such "surplus labor" labels are given to areas with more than 6 per cent of their work force idle. They now apply to 45 of the 149 major areas covered by a new Labor Department survey.

BÖNN, Germany (UP)—Foreign Minister Heinrich Von Brantano said today West Germany was not prepared to renounce nuclear weapons for its forces. He also said it would not deny them to allied troops stationed in West Germany. Brentan opened a foreign affairs debate by telling the crowded Bundestag Parliament that such moves would be "dangerous and utopian" in face of the Soviet threat.
