SAN DIEGO, Calif. (UPI) — Convair has successfully completed the maiden test flight of the 880 jet transport, described as the world's "tastest commercial aircraft."

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Selective Service Director Lewis B. Hershey proposed today that draft-exempt young men be trained for civil defense.

DURHAM (UPI) — The election of new officers and an address by U. S. Information Director George V. Allen today highlighted the closing session of the annual meeting of the North Carolina Council of Churches.

NORFOLK, Va. (UPI) — Two men who lived eight days on fruit juice and biscuits in an open dingy after their yacht sank in heavy gale were on their way to Mayport, Fla., today, giving thanks to a Dutch baron who saved their lives. The men, George Harrington, 27, a lawyer from Kew Gardens, N. Y., and Marson Crowwell, 24, a boat-builder from Riverport, N. J., were described in a terse bulletin from the Dutch aircraft carrier Karel Doorman as "thinner, nevertheless in good condition."

NORFOLK, Va. (UPI) — Virginia's largest city stood on the threshold of integration today. Barring a 1st-minute legal maneuver or some still-to-be-devised action from the state level, 17 Negro students will walk into six previously-white schools Monday, ending a legal battle started May 10, 1956.

LEOPOLDVILLE, Belgian Congo (UPI) — Armed troops were called out today to control bands of Africans stoning European-owned cars and looting buildings.

FAYETTEVILLE (UPI) — Two members of a New England firm which has contracted to study the feasibility of an inland port here have arrived to begin the ground-work for their survey.

RALEIGH (UPI) — The State Supreme Court today ruled unconstitutional an act creating the North Carolina Freeman's Pension Fund. The court said there was "discrimination and lack of uniformity" in the statute passed by the 1957 Legislature.

WASHINGTON (UPI) — The 1958 Mother of the Year, Mrs. David R. Coker of Hartsville, S. C., had a "friendly chat" with President Eisenhower today about the importance of mothers in bringing about international understanding.

Clinton Girl 'Home' From Cuban Turmoil

The former Jane Vann of Clinton, who married a Cuban businessman several years ago and was in Havana when the rebel forces of Fidel Castro took over, has arrived in Clinton with her three children for a visit.

Her husband, a second general Scot named Alberto McGrigor, is still in Havana, but she says she has no fears for his safety. McGrigor is chief meteorologist at the Jose Marti Airport.

Mrs. McGrigor met her husband when she was a stewardess with Chicago-Southern Airlines flying to Cuba.

Mrs. McGrigor is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Isaiah Vann of Clinton. Her mother became frantic when she did not hear from her daughter for several weeks during the uprising that overthrew the Batista government, but was reassured when the daughter told her that communications of all kinds had been disrupted.

The Clinton native said that when she left Cuba, no natives were being allowed to depart. But she and the three children had no trouble, since they had status as U. S. citizens.
