Company Men Sealed Off Inside Plant

PITTSBURGH (UPI) - Jones & Laughlin Steel Corp. asked the courts today to break up mass picket lines of striking United Steelworkers which the company declared have "unlawfully" imprisoned supervisory employes in three Pennsylvania plants.

The legal action, first of the six-day walkout of 500,000 basic steel workers, came as the government's top negotiator, Joseph F. Finnegan, was striving in New York to get negotiators for the union and industry back to the bargaining table.
