Trio Facing Liquor Charge

Three Dunn area men are awaiting trial of charges of engaging in illicit manufacturing of whiskey in Bladen County.

They were given a hearing before a United States Commissioner in Wilmington Thursday.

James McLain, Dunn, and James Capps and Haywood Stewart, both of Benson, were released under \$500 bond for the next term of U. S. District Court in Wilmington.

They were arrested by ATTO agents in the White Oak section of Bladen County Wednesday.

Agents said the three men were at a still site where 96 gallons of non-taxpaid whiskey were located. The still was a steam outfit with a capacity of 3,600 gallons.

Also found at the still site were 1,600 gallons of mash.

Confiscated was a 1953 Buick car and numerous pieces of equipment such as a steam boiler and a still.
