A graduate of Clemson A. & M. College, he received his master's degree at the University of Kentucky and his doctorate from Rutgers University.

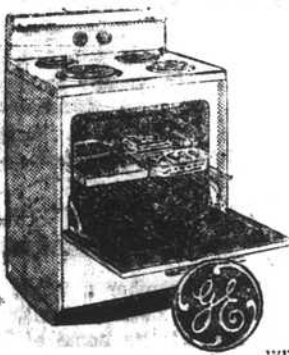
He is also president and treasurer of Pee Dee Equipment Company, dealing in farm equipment and supplies, and is a farm owner

The Soda Shop will also feature a variety of sandwiches. It has been remodeled with booths added.

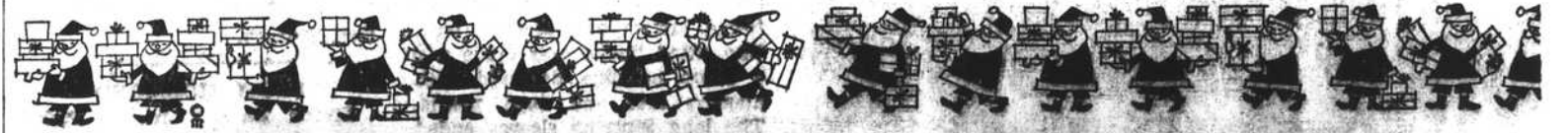
Jobs Now Open With The Town
