Hoffa's Lawyer Still Disbarred

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (UPI) — Two judges refused to review a disbarment action which touched off a new grand jury investigation into alleged jury tampering in federal cases against Teamsters Union President James R. Hoffa.

U. S. District Court Judges William E. Miller and Frank Gray Jr. rejected a request to suspend their order disbarring E. T. Osborn Jr., one of Hoffa's attorneys.

Osborn was disbarred from federal court here last month on the grounds of attempting to offer a \$10,000 bribe for a vote of acquittal in the forthcoming jury tampering trial of the union leader.
