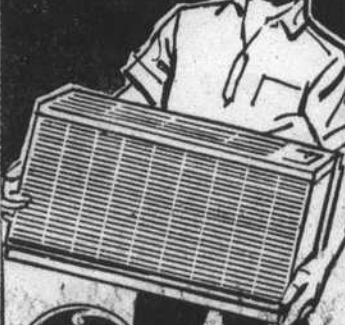
## Two Hostesses Have Class Meet
