400 Are Searching For Missing Trio

PHILADELPHIA, Miss. (UPI) — A force of sailors hunting for three missing civil rights workers was increased today from 200 to 400 men. The search for the three young men, missing since June 21, involved dragging creeks, ponds and lakes and careful probing through the underbrush. "You might say we are as much in the dark as we were at the start," said Sheriff Lawrence Rainey.

The search was broadened Monday to include all of Mississippi and the four surrounding states of Louisiana, Arkansas, Tennessee and Alabama when FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover ordered leaflets with pictures of the three men mailed into the states.

However, White House Press Secretary George Reedy said the leaflets did not mean that the FBI believed the three men had left the state.
