Great Adventure Features Sam Houston Story

Robert Culp, Victor Jory and Mario Alcalde star in "The Testing of Sam Houston," story of the early career of Sam Houston, famed soldier and politician, on "The Great Adventure" Friday, July 24 (7:30-8:30 pm, EDT) on the CBS Television Network. (Rebroadcast; OAD 1-31-64)

The drama traces Houston's career from his service as a lieutenant in the War of 1812 through his election as Governor of Tennessee and unhappy marriage to Eliza Allen, to his trial by the Congress for attacking Ohio Representative William Stanbery in a street brawl.

Culp has the title role, Jory stars as Andrew Jackson, under whom Houston fought against the Creek Indians in the Battle of Horseshoe Bend and who was later to become a close friend of Houston. Alcalde also stars as Too-Chee-La, Houston's Cherokee blood brother.

Co-starring are Katherine Crawford as Eliza Allen, Robert Emhardt as Stanbery, Kent Smith as William Carroll, Houston's predecessor as Governor, and David White as John C. Calhoun, Secretary of War, to whom Houston appealed for fair treatment of the Cherokees in 1818.

Featured players include Ralph Moody as Oo-Loo Techka, Cherokee chief who adopted Houston. Tom Paler and June Vincent as Eliza's parents, and Francis De Sales as Speaker of the House.

John Forsythe Stars On Playhouse
