Ends Crusade In Nebraska

Billy Draws Huge Crowd In Omaha

OMAHA, Neb. (UPI) — Evangelist Billy Graham drew a record 26,000 persons to the Ak-Sar-Ben Race Track Sunday for the final message of his 10-day crusade.

The previous record, set last Memorial Day at the horse races, was 24,316.

Ak-Sar-Ben officials said "we are very pleased that the attendance record was broken at a religious meeting."

Graham said in his final message to the Omaha Crusade that many of the conditions present in the world are similar to those described in the Bible, as preceding the end of the world.

He said "Jesus said that before

the end, race will be fighting race, evil will intensify and there will be immorality."

An estimated 1,650 "inquirers" came forward after the sermon. Following the services Graham left by plane from Eppley Air Field for New York. He will open a crusade at Boston Gardens, Boston, Mass., Friday.

**Good Records
Essential For
Farm Hands**

Do you employ regular or part time workers on your farm? C. V. Shelton, Social Security Representative for Harnett County asked today. Do you keep good records of the time and wages of these workers?

You should keep these records to establish the amount of social security taxes you owe. Most farmers keep a record of the amount of wages paid each employee, but this is not a complete job of recordkeeping. Good records include (1) the amount of cash wages paid these employees, (2) the time each actually worked, and (3) their social security numbers.

The social security tax should be withheld from the employee's wages during the period he works even though you do not know how long he will stay with you. A farm worker's wages are subject to social security tax if you pay him as much as \$150 during the year or if the worker is employed on 20 or more days during the year and paid on a time basis — by the hour, day, or week.

If he works less than 20 days and is not paid as much as \$150 during the year, you should refund the tax withheld from his wages. If he meets either of the two tests, the social security taxes must be paid.

Under the law, the employer is held responsible for both the employee and employer tax for social security purposes. It is apparent that a record of the time worked and the wages paid is necessary in order to determine which employees to report. The actual report form requires a social security number for each employee.

Most farmers get the social security numbers of their full-time employees but sometimes fail to get those of their part-time workers. These part-time employees present a problem because they often quit or the job is finished before the farmer gets a record of the numbers. A good system used by many employers is to insist on seeing the social security card before paying the first week's wages. This should be understood by the worker at the time he is hired.

If the employee does not have a social security card or has lost his card, ask him to get an application form for a social security number from the nearest post office. After he has completed this card and mailed it to his local social security district office, he will receive his card in about 10 days.

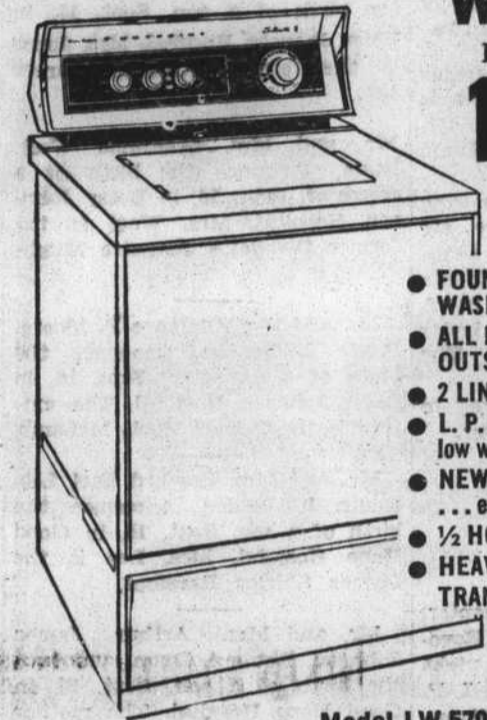

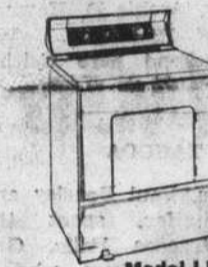

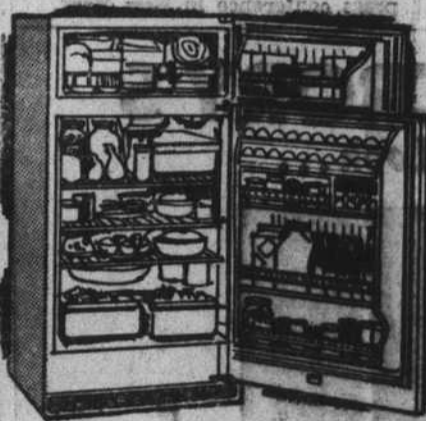
