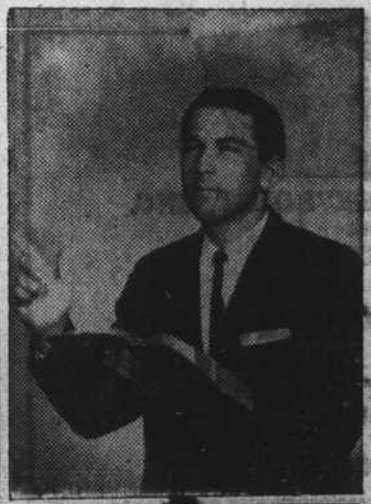

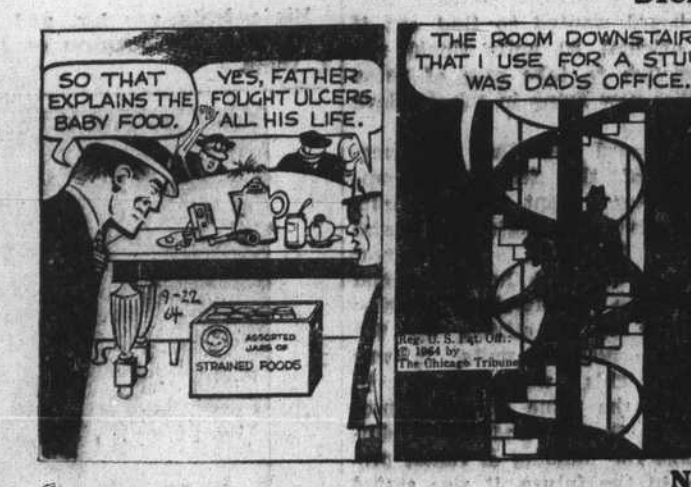
**ON GUIDED MISSILE FRIGATE**
