## Woman Shoots Hubby Over \$113

**WINSTON - SALEM (UPI)** — Police said a factory worker was shot in the head by his wife Tuesday during an argument over an unpaid \$113 automobile repair bill.  
William Howard Harvey, 24, was in critical condition today at a local hospital. His 31-year-old wife, Ina Jean, was held on open charges.

Garage owner Jack Stoltz told police that the Harveys had come to his office Tuesday to discuss an automobile repair bill when Mrs. Harvey "just pulled that gun out and placed it next to his head and shot."

Harvey was shot in the left temple with a .32 - caliber pistol. Mrs. Harvey told detectives her husband had given her the money to pay the garage bill but she used it to buy Christmas presents for their three children. She said her husband took her to the garage to deliberately embarrass her.

Lady Bird Johnson celebrated her 52nd birthday Tuesday overlooking the final yuletide preparations. The only problem she has left is finding the right spot for a favorite Christmas ornament, a handmade angel sent to her by a friend in Germany.

The President gave Lady Bird a simple gold brooch as a birthday present. She opened her presents at breakfast. There was no big party.

Four red satin stockings inscribed "Daddy," "Mother," "Lynda," and "Luci" have been hung from the mantle. They have been used by the first family since the Johnson daughters were little girls 16 years ago.

They will bulge with the Christmas gifts the family plans to open on Christmas Eve, as is their custom.

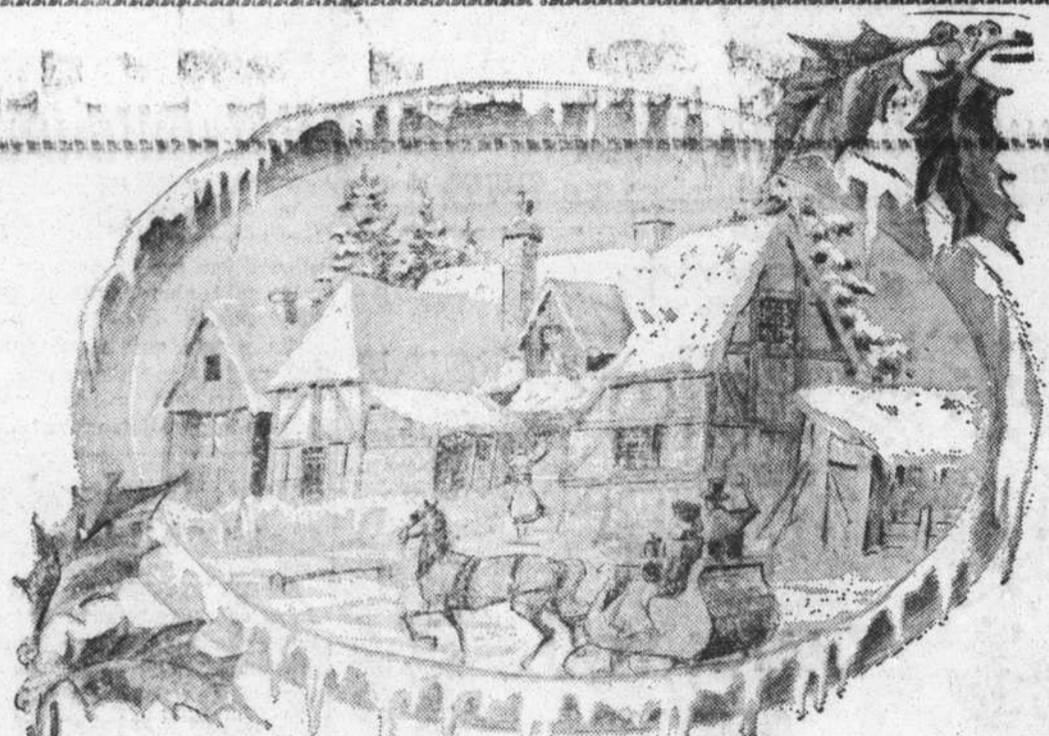
"It is felt that money used in this fashion will be meaningful to many people and that it can be put to good use, particularly at this time of year," Bridgers said.
