Child Care Center Opens

In West Boulevard Area

Good news has come to the parents in the Ponderosa, Little Rock Homes, Boulevard Homes, and West Boulevard areas with the opening of the Phifer House Nursery and Child Care Center at 3100 West Blvd.

With the increasing need for nurseries and kindergartens, especially in black communities, another black Charlottean with foresight, has ventured out to help eliminate this community need.

She is Mrs. Barbara Jean Watson, a native Charlottean who returned to the Queen City five years ago. The new owner, Director, and manager of the just-opened Phifer House Nursery, with a capacity for 38 children, is married to S-6gt Robert H. Watson, who serves full-time with the North Carolina National Guard. The couple has two sons; Steven, 16, and Kenneth, 11, and reside at 409 W. Cama Street.

While accomodating up to 38 children, through the age of 5, the Phifer House Nursery and Child Care Center will offer, in addition to its regular weekday services, a unique weekend baby-sitting service on Friday evening from 6 P.M. until 12 midnight and on Saturday from 1 P.M. until midnight.

Mrs. Watson says "Her love for children inspired her to

channel her humanitarian efforts in the direction of a nursery." She has worked in the area of childhood development in Charlotte and in Brooklyn, N.Y.

The 38-year-old Mrs. Watson said, "she and her associates have spent countless hours preparing the nursery to meet the needs of the children-it will serve in the Charlotte area

and also the requirements of the State of North Carolina Licensing Board."

September 29th will be the official opening day of the Phifer House Nursery and Child Care Center which is housed in a 7-room building situated on a spacious 105x165 lot at its 3100 West Blvd. location between the Ponderosa and Little Rock Homes residential sections.
