On January 7, WBTV and WBT enjoyed one of the most outstanding days in their long broadcast history. Outstanding, because 1,549 units of blood were collected at their studios during the fifth annual "WBTV-WBT BLOOD GIVE-IN" setting a new national record for a one-day effort. Donors of all sizes, shapes and colors came from Charlotte and the surrounding communities to give their most precious, private possession to the Red Cross, for free.
