Carolina Paper Faces Discrimination Charges

Harris Williams, EEOC district director, said his agency now has 2,700 charges of discrimination on file. Although he does not think employee pay discrimination is a trend among the state's employers, he indicated there may be a number of violations.

Williams estimated that 70 percent of the complaints made with his agency can be proved. He said EEOC action is enough to get most employers to correct discrimina-

tion problems, but sometimes either the EEOC or the complainant takes the case to court.

Chambers estimated the average litigation period for these cases at two years. He said it takes time to prepare the cases and to get them on court dockets.

The well known civil rights attorney said most employers are aware of their liability under anti-discrimination laws but violations are still not isolated.
