21 Girls To Vie For 1976 Delta Deb


An enchanting and exciting evening is being planned by the Charlotte Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority for April 9.

ployment rate at 13.7 for blacks (Negro and other races) was little changed in February and also has shown little change over the past year. In January the rate had been 13.2 percent, 13.8 percent in Dec-ember and 13.9 percent in November ..

or Statistics, the jobless rate for white workers continued to decrease - to 6.8 percent in February. It had been 7.1 in January
