8 In Ethnic-Folk Music Residency

Eight Charlotte-Mecklenburg public schools are participating this week (March 29-April 1) in an "Ethnic-Folk Music Residency" program sponsored by the N.C. State Department of Public Instruction's Division of Cultural Arts.

The program will bring into local schools Peg Leg Sam, a harmonica player; Andy Cohen, guitarist and pianist; and a bluegrass band.

The program, which began in the spring of 1974, is designed to give school students a chance to become a part of their musical heritage. Settings are provided so that students may meet, mingle and talk with the musicians.

The music and the musicians have a direct oral and aural lineage to the beginnings of music in the state. A full spectrum of indigenous music is presented through

the program, including traditional string bands, bluegrass, ballad singing, blues, dulcimer playing, ragtime, gospel, dobro picking and the unique lyrical tradition "Hollerin'." Participating schools are Billingsville Elementary, Alexander Graham Junior High, Garinger High, Hawthorne Junior High, Myers Park Traditional Elementary, Myers Park High, Pineville Elementary, and Northwest Junior High.
