College Receives

Kresge Grant

The Kresge Foundation has awarded a challenge grant of \$50,000 to Sacred Heart College to aid in the renovation of Mercedes Hall. The original structure, built in 1897, was the Motherhouse for the Sisters of Mercy of Belmont until the mid-1960's. The renovated structure will contain a student chapel, language laboratory and classrooms for use by the College and the English language centen. A bookstore and other services temporarily housed in the building will be moved to a new facil-

The grant was awarded in recognition of the need for the facilities and to encourage local businesses and individuals to help support the \$330,000 renovation project.

"The renovation of Mercedes Hall is vitally important to Sacred Heart's growth and service to the community," said Sister M. Michel Boulus, president of the College. "The renovation will provide badly needed classroom space for our programs in special education, our expanded evening program, and the English Language Center, as well as a language laboratory and a student chapel.

The grant from The Kresge Foundation, an earlier grant of \$150,000, and some local support leave the College with approximately \$100,000 to be raised to complete the project. "According to the conditions of the grant, we have until February to raise the balance of the funds; however, we hope to raise the money in the next few months because the use of current facilities is already over extended," said Sister Michel

During the past 53 years, The Kresge Foundation has made appropriations of more than \$260 million to institutions in the fields of higher education, health services, the arts, social welfare, and the care of the young and aging. Construction and major renovation of facilties is the Foundation's primary concern, and grants are usually made on a challenge basis to encourage further fund raising efforts.

The Foundation, one of the largest in the United States in size of assets and appropriations, was created solely through the gifts of the late Sebastian S. Kresge, founder of the S.S. Kresge Company. However, the Company and the Foundation are not related in any way.

Only a few years ago, rehabilitation for the stroke patient came late, if at all. From the recent advances in acute care, and from the developments in leading rehabilitation hospitals, procedures have emerged which offer new hope to the patient and the family. The North Carolina Heart Association has developed these into a program which can be implemented in hospitals throughout the state.

The program is based on a

team approach with the physician, nurse, therapists and family working together to restore the maximum capacities possible to the patient. Physical rehabilitation is begun immediately upon stabilization of the patient's vital signs. The first phase is termed "Passive range of motion" and often may be initiated before the patient regains consciousness. This procedure prevents the muscles from tightening and becoming "set". It has been discovered that if this process is delayed, more ultimate disability can result than from the immedi-




