In conference play Morgan State played tough defense to defeat North Carolina Central. 12-10 while Delaware State blanked winless Maryland-Eastern Shore, 13-0.

North Carolina A&T and Morgan State are the only unbeaten teams in conference play with 1-0 league marks while S.C. State has a 2-1 family record and Delaware State and Howard both have 1-1 records




