Eugene "Dynamite" Dunn was honored for his over 40-years of service as an athletic coach in Gastonia Sunday, November 28.

Former athletes who played for Dunn organized the ceremony. It was held at Mollock Elks Lodge, in the building that once housed Highland High School.

Robert Mason, assistant principal of Ashbrook High School, chaired the group that sponsored the program. Dunn was given a plaque, shotgun and other gifts.

Speaker for the occasion

was George Miller, assistant superintendent of the Gaston County School System.

About 200 people braved poor weather to attend the event.

High points of Dunn's career include a state football championship in 1946, state baseball championship in 1951, five conference football championships and six conference basketball championships.

Mason said he will always remember Dunn as a fundamentalist and strong disciplinarian.

Dunn retired in 1973.
