Legislative Committee on Property Tax changes in registration of motor vehicles in North Carolina patterned after Georgia and several other states to eliminate vehicles that are not taxed and long registration lines at license renewal pe-

much pressure is put on the entire department that "it takes as long as six months to recover." He said that staggered registration would sell tags to one tenth of the vehicles for ten months thus reducing the load. The program could begin as soon as 1978.

Representative Bob Jones explained to the legislators how a system of registering vehicles at county courthouses would catch approximately 15 percent of the vehicles that are estimated to escape the county tax rolls. Jones said that coupled with staggered registration county tax collectors who don't discover vehicles owned by "students and apartment dwellers" would sell the tags. To get a tag

Ed Wade did not agree that coupling staggered registration with registration at County Courthouses would work. He said "Anytime you change how you handle 4 million of anything you are going to have trouble." To avoid problems Wade said that staggered registration and county registration should be implemented at different times.

Mecklenburg County Tax Collector J.A. Stone and several other collectors present were in favor of the system outlined by Jones. Stone said that in Mecklenburg County 2400 of the 260,000 vehicles registered and owned in the county were not listed with the county tax collector during fiscal year 76. He said that amounted to a loss of one million dollars or more of. revenue to the county.
