

Mayfield Memorial Church Will Dedicate Its All-New Day Care Center

On Monday, January 3, 1977, the Mayfield Memorial Baptist Church will have a grand opening of its all-new day care center. In observance of this, the church will host an "Open House" to be held on Sunday, January 2, 1977. The public is cordially invited to visit Mayfield and look over the entire property.

Mayfield is an outstanding edifice with 54 rooms on three levels. On the ground floor is housed the administration center, the reception area, the media center, the worship center, a robe room for the church's five choirs, and an ushers and first aid room. The worship center contains a chapel that seats approximately 600 persons.

On the lower level is found the day care center, fellowship hall, and kitchen facilities. The day care center also includes the administration suite enclosing the Director's Office and a reception area.

The top floor houses the educational facilities and the nursery used during the worship service. The main building covers more than 25,000 square feet of floor space.

The ground floor of the main building also includes the office of the Director of Sunday School and BTU, the Senior Citizen's classroom, the Secretary's office and workroom, the Pastor's office, a conference room, the men's and women's lounges, and the Junior and Senior Missionaries rooms. Mayfield has an A-1 circle of Missionaries.

The worship center includes along with the Chapel, the Baptistery and a lovely Narthex.

Mayfield also has a bus ministry with 12 and 15 passenger mini buses that will provide pick-up and delivery service for the day care center for those who desire it.

Basic Adult Education classes for grades 8 and below and Adult Education Classes for high school completion are held on Monday and Tuesday evenings. These classes are sponsored by Central Piedmont Community College who provide the teachers for the classes. Sewing classes are held each Friday evening at the church also. Consumer Education and Music Appreciation classes are proposed for the future.

Mayfield also has a softball team, "The Mayfield Raiders," with a development of a basketball team in the making. The Athletic Director of the church is Mr. Gresham, a member of the New York Jets football team.

The members invite all to come out and view their church. The beautiful edifice is located at 700 Sugar Creek Road West and is situated on a 3 1/2 acre track of land surrounded with beautiful pines. There are three buildings on the site, the main building, the Young Adult Missionaries House, and a Scout Hut. The construction of a new 1,000-seat sanctuary is scheduled to begin within the next twelve months.

Mayfield Memorial Baptist Church is Charlotte's fastest growing church in the community today. With only seven years of existence, it has more than 1,100 members.
