The new Minister of the Second Calvary Baptist Church will be formally installed during what promises to be a very solemn and impressive ceremony and service. Rev. Lemar Foster, former Pastor of the Mt. Hebron Baptist Church in Gastonia, North Carolina, where he served for eight years, was born in Charlotte, and attended the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Public Schools. He is a 1959 graduate of York Road High School with honors as the Class Valedictorian and with the highest academic average of any student in the entire system at that time. He was named in the Charlotte News as an "All-Star Scholar" during the same year. Graduating Cum Laude from Johnson C. Smith University in 1963, he received a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Social Psychology and Religious Education. He has pursued further graduate study at

the following: the American Bible College in Kansas City, Missouri, and the Urban Training Center for Christian Missions in Chicago, Illinois, and the Ambassador College Extension in Pasadena, California. He attended the Urban Training Center with the aid of a Ford Foundation Grant and received a Certificate in recognition of his completion of studies there. In 1971, he received his Doctor of Divinity Degree from the Neotarian College of Philosophy in Kansas City, Missouri. Rev. Foster is a member of the Sigma Rho Sigma Professional Society of the Social Sciences. Rev. Lemar Foster is mar-


