

WSOC To Air Story Of Princess Grace

"The Story of Princess Grace...Once Upon a Time Is Now" will be presented on Channel Nine's "The Big Event" Sunday, May 22 at 9:30 p.m. Lee Grant is host.

The special features film celebrities in personal reminiscences and a rare glimpse of Princess Grace in special sequences with her family, including Princess Caroline, filmed in Monaco, Paris and London.

The program includes on-camera interviews with film stars William Holden, James Stewart, Alec Guinness and Raymond Massey. Cary Grant narrates a sequence.

There are also on-camera interviews with noted film personalities who were associated with Princess Grace during her movie career, including director Alfred Hitchcock, producer-director Stanley Kramer, noted designer Edith Head and director George Seaton.

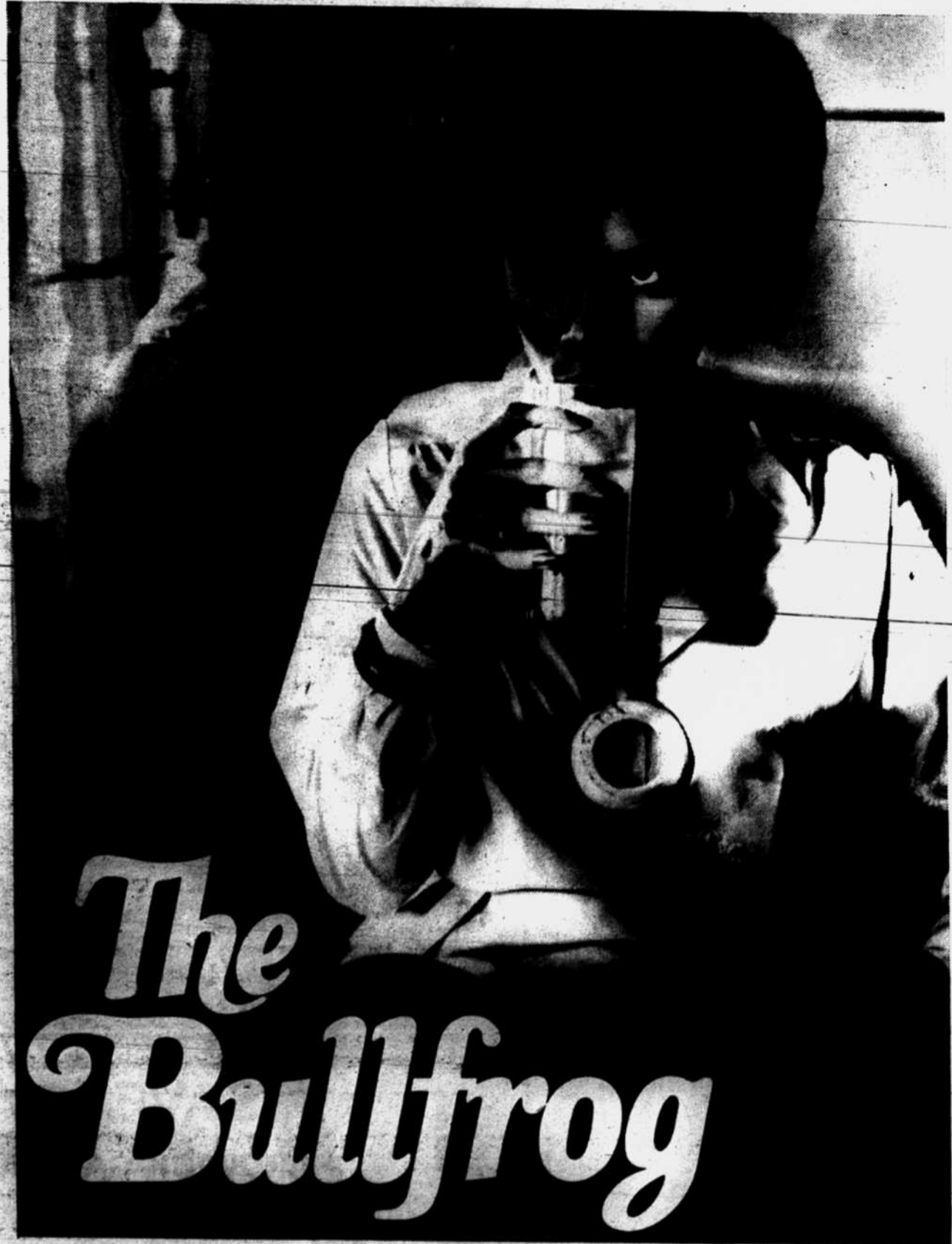
Unique footage of Princess Grace filmed for the program shows her with her husband, Prince Rainier, and their daughter, Princess Caroline. Princess Caroline, in what is believed to be the first film footage of her in an earnest conversation with her mother, is seen with Princess Grace in the Bois de Boulogne in Paris. Other on-location scenes were taken in the royal palace in Monaco and in the Monaco Legation in London.

In presenting an original view of Princess Grace from film princess to royal princess, the program will include footage of her early days as a model in New York, as she appeared in television com-

mercials and kinescope scenes of her as a performer in live TV dramas.

Film highlights of her notable career in Hollywood will include scenes from "The Country Girl" with William Holden, for which she won an Oscar as Best Actress.

Why does hair break

ANSWER:
Hair is dead, after it leaves the scalp. It must be treated and cared for to stop damage and breakage on a regular basis. The life of a hair may be a few months or several years; an eye lash, about 2½ to 4½ months; to a scalp hair up to five years. Hair is shed more during the hot summer months. Maybe 50 to 150 hairs a day, that are hopefully, with care, replaced.
