WBTV To Bring Back Old Films

Some all-time favorite films will be shown in a "Spring Movie Festival" during prime time, from 9 til 11 p.m. on WBTV beginning Thursday, May 26.

The first of the movies is "The Thomas Crown Affair," an intriguing, exciting story about a multi-millionaire who executes a daring daylight robbery of a bank, and gets away with two million in cash. Steve McQueen is the mastermind criminal and Faye Dunaway is the insurance investigator who thinks he's guilty, but falls for him anyway.

The second film, to be seen on Tuesday, May 31, is "The Devil's Brigade," a World War II thriller about a special unit formed by a lieutenant colonel consisting of a trained and disciplined team of Canadians and a motley crew of American misfits. On Friday, June 3, the riotous comedy, "Not With My Wife, You Don't," will be seen. Tony Curtis and George C. Scott play two friendly, but competitive, Air Force officers who vie for the attentions of a beautiful Italian nurse, Virna Lisi. The fourth and final film in the "Spring Movie Festival" is the classic, "A Streetcar Named Desire," which will be shown on Wednesday, June 8. Winner of 5 Academy Awards, "Streetcar" is an explosive drama showing the slow disintegration of a neurotic Southern belle by the constant badgering of her sister's brutish husband. Vivien Leigh, Marlon Brando, Kim Hunter and Karl Malden head a superlative cast in this outstanding film based on the play by Tennessee Williams.
