

# Kansas City To Host USCAASR's 91st Convention

The 91st Annual Session of the United Supreme Council, 33, A.A.S.R., Southern Jurisdiction (Prince Hall Affiliation) will be held October 1 - 4 in Kansas City, Mo., announced Dr. John G. Lewis Jr. of Baton Rouge, La., sovereign grand commander.

All sessions and convocation-related events will be held at the Muehlebach Hotel, including the Divine Service, 7 p.m., Sunday. The Rev. John W. Williams, pastor of St. Stephen Baptist Church, Kansas City, Mo., will deliver the eulogy.

The Council will open officially Monday, 8:30 a.m. Dr. Lewis will deliver the Sovereign

Grand Commander's Allocation at 11 a.m. Later at 2:30 p.m., the thirty-third degree (honorary) will be conferred on 229 candidates. Dr. Lewis will preside over the convocation, assisted by Dr. I.H. Clayborn of Dallas, Tex., lieutenant grand commander. Drs. Lewis and Clayborn are also grand masters of Louisiana and Texas, respectively.

Highlights include: Saturday, 12 noon luncheon and conference for Deputies and Active Members; 9 p.m., Reception for all members and guests; Sunday, 9 a.m., Executive Breakfast Session; 2 p.m., Organization of Class of '77, and 7 p.m., Divine Service; Monday, 8:30 a.m., Opening of Supreme Council in Full Ceremonial; 12:30 p.m., Luncheon, 2 p.m., Executive Session, 2:30 p.m., Confering of Thirty-Third Degree, and 7:30 p.m., Annual Class Banquet in honor of the Class of '77. The Council will close Tuesday afternoon.

Class reunions will be held by those Classes elevated in a year whose last numeral is one, two or three. Fred Alexander of Gainesville, Fla., is in charge of class activities. The Divine Service on Sunday is open to the public without charge. Monday's

banquet is by reservation. A feature of the banquet will be the presentation of awards

and citations for services to the masonic order, community and nation.

## 48 CMS Schools To Get Safety Awards

Forty eight schools in Charlotte-Mecklenburg have qualified for Perfect Safety Awards in the Green Pennant Traffic Safety Program, reports Safety Director, Joe Green. These schools completed the 1976-77 academic year without accidents involving any of their school children.

Schools participating in the program earn the right to fly a pennant from their flagstaff by completing a 30-day accident-free period. The pen-

nants will continue to fly as long as there are no accidents. If one occurs, the pennant is withdrawn and displayed inside the school for a 30-day safety review period.

The Green Pennant Traffic Safety Program is aimed at making students conscious of the vital need for traffic safety. It recognizes those schools with outstanding traffic safety performances.

### Vote Tuesday

On Tuesday, primary election day, registered Democrats will have the opportunity to vote for their party's choice of a candidate for mayor from a field of four and for four council at-large candidates from a field of eight.
