## Roebuck Grant

SALISBURY - Eugene Myers, a representative of the Sears-Roebuck Foundation, presented a check to Dr. F. George Shipman. President of Livingstone College, today at a special presentation on the Livingstone College campus.

The North Carolina colleges and universities are among almost 1,000 private accredited two and four year institutions across the country which are sharing in \$1,500,000 in Sears Foundation funds for the 1977-78 academic year. Funds may be used unrestrictedly as the colleges and universities deem necessary.

Grants totalling more than \$48,000.00 will be distributed to 39 privately supported colleges and universities in North Carolina this week by the Sears - Roebuck Foundation. ,

In the Salisbury area, Catawba College and Livingstone College will receive grants totaling \$2,526.00.

In addition to its unrestricted grant program, the Sears-Roebuck Foundation each year conducts a variety of special-purpose programs in elementary, secondary, higher, and continuing education. Altogether, the Foundation had expenditures of over \$2, 500,000.00 in 1977 for its education activities.
