For Sheriff

Candidates

ECO, the Ex-Convicts Organization, will hold a forum for candidates for Sheriff Tuesday, April 4, at 7:30 p.m. at First Presbyterian Church, located at 200 West Trade Street.

Each of the candidates present will be asked questions concerning law enforcement, criminal justice and corrections, by a panel moderated by Park Todds, who has worked with prisoners both as a director of Volunteers in Service to America and as a member of the staff of The Division of Youth Services in Raleigh, and the North Carolina Department of Corrections.

Panelists questioning the candidates will include Jim Black, of WGIV-Radio; Louise Fowler, an attorney; Art Griffin of the Legal Aid Society; Willie Stratford of the U. S. Postal Service; and Monsignor Hugh Dolan of St. Gabriel's Catholic Church.

The candidates vying for the Democratic nomination for Sheriff of Mecklenburg County are Bobby Jock Cain, 2841 Attaberry Drive; Ed Cobb, 9051 Singing Pine Road; Norman Craig Freeman, Route 3, Box 38F, Steele Creek Road; Vivian Galloway, 438 Vickery Drive; James F. (Jim) Kirk, 9050 Nash Avenue; Peter Loftis, 1535 Lansdale Drive; and John Kelly Wall, 7333 Lancer Drive.

Sheriff Donald Stahl, who is unopposed for the Republican nomination, declined to participate. "I'm a politician," he said. "It wouldn't do me any good to appear on the program with those fellows."

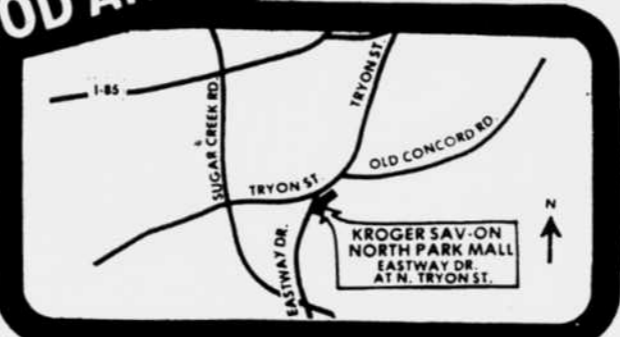
