Dr. Bertha Lyons Maxwell is returning to UNCC as Frank Porter Graham Professor of Afro-American and African Studies and Director of the Afro-American and African Studies Program. She is returning to the position she left in January, 1977 to become Vice President for Administrative Affairs at Johnson C. Smith University. Her appointment is effective July 1.
