Night two shows Kunta Kinte's involvement in the revolt attempt during the voyage to America. Upon reaching the world, he is immediately sold to his first owner where he meets his friend Fiddler. Naturally his stay with the new owner is umpleasant and Kunta makes several attempts to escape. Lorne Greene, Louis Gossett Jr. and Vic. Morrow are the stars added to night two. The year 1776 finds Kunta Kinte is the same rebellious state that he was in when he first reached America. His final escape

attempt cost him his right foot. This along with the birth of his daughter, Kizzy, cools him out considerably. Fiddler convinces him to marry a slave woman, Bell who gives birth to his only daughter, Kizzy. Years later, Kizzy helps a young slave run away. As punishment, she is immediately sold and is raped by her new owner. John Amos, Madge Sinclair, Robert Reed, Lynda Day George, Leslie Uggans Lawrence-Hilton Jacobs, Sandy Duncan, and Chuck Connors all star in night three's presentation.

On Friday, September 8, Ben Vereen, George Hamilton, Richard Roundtree, Carolyn Jones, and Olivia Cole star as Kizzy's son, Chicken George trains his way to freedom. His master and father raises chickens, Mr. Bennett who is a man in the same profession, wants to buy Chicken George, but he is sent with him to pay his owners debt instead and is promised to be a free man when he returns. At the same time, Kizzy is asked for her hand in marriage by an Uncle Tom

type slave. Reflecting on the memory of father's struggle against slavery, she refused. News of Nat Turner's rebellion reaches the plantation and the owner's wife is terrified of all the slaves and is protected only by her husband's gun.

The final episode of "Roots" captures Chicken George's return as a free man. He finds his son married and is acting head of the family. George's freedom is deeply resented especially with the talk of slave abolition in the air.
