The Stillman College Singers of Tuscaloosa, Alabama will appear at South Tryon Presbyterian Church, 2516 South Tryon Street on Sunday, November 12 at 5:30 p.m. This appearance is part of a fall tour through the states of Georgia, North Carolina, and South Carolina. Included in the tour is a three-day apperance at the Consultation on Partnership in a Culturally Plural Church sponsored by the Presbyterian Church in the United States to be held at Montreat, North Carolina.

The Stillman Singers is a group of thirteen young singers selected by audition from the Stillman College Choir. The group has toured in more than ten states and has made apperances at Montreat conferences, Presbyterian meetings, and Mission Rallies. During the 1977 tour, the group toured the West Virginia State Capitol Building and was received by Gov. John D. Rockerteller, IV.

The Director of the group is Professor James Arthur Williams, Chairman of the Stillman College Music Department. Professor Williams holds degrees from Allen University and the University of Illinois and, in 1967, was a fellow in the Institute for Advanced Study in Aesthetic Education at the University of Illinois. In 1974, Professor Williams was one of 18 Alabama college professors selected to spend six weeks in Poland to study Polish culture. He will direct and accompany the program which will consist of sacred selections, Negro spirituals, show tunes, operatic excerpts, and Black Gospel
